**MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 11-032**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY REAPPROPRIATING \$55,850 FROM THE TRAILS MANAGEMENT DIVISION FISCAL YEAR 2011 OPERATING BUDGET, FUND 100, AND \$44,150 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ADMINISTRATION DIVISION FISCAL YEAR 2011 OPERATING BUDGET, FUND 100, TO FUND 440, PROJECT NO. 15015, AUTHORIZING THE BOROUGH MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE MAT-SU TRAILS AND PARKS FOUNDATION FOR THE TRAILS MANAGEMENT AND PUBLIC ENGAGEMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Borough desires to encourage the participation of interested not-for-profit organizations in providing supplemental services, including trail building and maintenance for the benefit of the public; and

WHEREAS, the Mat-Su Trails and Parks Foundation (MSTPF) has been formed to address these considerable interests and build on the momentum the Matanuska-Susitna Borough has created for the establishment of a first class trails and parks system for residents and visitors to the area; and

WHEREAS, since this project will not be completed prior to June 30, 2011, it is necessary to move these funds into a non-lapsing, capital project fund; and

WHEREAS, this reappropriation is intended to fund a grant agreement to the Mat-Su Trails and Park Foundation; and

WHEREAS, the scope of work and budget for the grant agreement is included in Resolution Serial No. 11-029 and must be approved by the Assembly prior to the expenditure of said funds.

BE IT ENACTED:


Section 1. Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Reappropriation source. There is hereby reappropriated by the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly \$55,850 from the Trails Management Division fiscal year 2011 operating budget, fund 100, and \$44,150 community development administration division fiscal year 2011 operating budget, fund 100, to fund 440, project no. 15015, for the Trails Management and Public Engagement project.

Section 3. Authorization. The Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly authorizes the Borough Manager to enter into a grant agreement with the Mat-Su Trails and Parks Foundation, for the Trails Management and Public Engagement project.

Section 4. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption by the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly.
