


Mat-Su Borough Salmon Fish Passage Program

Culvert Designations

- ★ Restored: Replaced to improve fish passage (new culvert or bridge)
- ▲ Assumed not adequate to pass juvenile salmon
- ▲ Marginal, or may not be adequate to pass juvenile salmon
- ▲ Assumed adequate to pass juvenile salmon

Map displays a subset of culverts surveyed in the Mat-Su Borough in and around the core area as of January, 2008. This subset includes a total of 251 culverts, 80% of which may be some kind of salmon barrier and 20% that likely pass juvenile and adult salmon. The fish passage restoration program has almost doubled the number of culverts that can adequately pass fish.
