



# Mat-Su Borough Salmon Fish Passage Program

## Culvert Designations

- ★ Restored to improve fish passage (new culvert or bridge) - 2014 Projects
- ▲ Restored to improve fish passage (new culvert or bridge) from 2001 to 2013
- ▲ Passes juvenile salmon
- ▲ Marginal, or may not be adequate to pass juvenile salmon
- ▲ Not adequate to pass juvenile salmon
- ▲ Not Assessed Yet



There are a total of 564 culverts that have been surveyed Borough wide regarding fish passage. Of those, 33% are now likely to pass juvenile and adult salmon, whereas 65% may be some kind of salmon barrier. Nearly 100 culverts have been made passable by the fish passage program since 2001.
