The boundaries of each election district are shown on a map available and posted at each polling place in the Matanuska-Susitna Borough.</p> <p>Shall the composition and form of representation of the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly, and the plan of apportionment for assembly districts, be approved as stated above?
