**MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 16-009**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROVING A REAPPROPRIATION OF \$100,000 FROM FUND 410, PROJECT NO. 30043, FOR BIG LAKE ROAD SERVICE AREA NO. 21 CAPITAL PROJECTS TO BIG LAKE ROAD SERVICE AREA NO. 21 FISCAL YEAR 2016 OPERATING BUDGET, FUND 277.

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department needs to transfer funds from capital projects to the fiscal year 2016 operating budget for Big Lake Road Service Area; and

WHEREAS, these funds are needed to purchase 1,500 tons of winter chips for application on the Big Lake Road Service Area roads; and

WHEREAS, 2,513 tons of chips have been purchased and supplied to the road maintenance contractor; and

WHEREAS, previously purchased chips for Big Lake Road Service Area have been applied; and

WHEREAS, there is not enough in the fiscal year 2016 operating budget to complete a purchase of 1,500 tons of chips; and

WHEREAS, there is not enough in the Big Lake Road Service fund balance to request a transfer to purchase the winter chips; and

WHEREAS, there is concern that road icing events will occur and there will be no product to place on the road.


BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Acceptance and appropriation source. The Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly hereby approves the reappropriation of \$100,000 from fund 410, project no. 30043, Big Lake Road Service Area No. 21 capital projects to Big Lake Road Service Area No. 21, operating budget, fund 277.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
