**MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 16-014**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY REQUESTING A REAPPROPRIATION OF \$13,968 FROM PROJECT NO. 45225, FUND 425, TO PROJECT NO. 10179, FUND 425, TO ALLOW FOR ADDITIONAL FUNDING TO CONTINUE WITH PHASE I OF THE SUTTON AMBULANCE BUILDING RENOVATION.

WHEREAS, in the 2012 capital projects budget, \$350,000 in areawide funds were appropriated for the Ambulance Facility Improvements at Station 3-9; and

WHEREAS, that project was completed and on August 15, 2014, \$28,775 of remaining funds was transferred into project no. 10179 with Resolution No. 14-063; and

WHEREAS, in the 2012 capital projects budget, \$60,000 in areawide funds were appropriated for the Parking Lot Expansion at Station 14-1; and

WHEREAS, that project was completed and on August 15, 2014, the remaining balance of \$35,000 was transferred into project no. 10179 with Resolution No. 14-063; and

WHEREAS, in the 2014 capital projects budget, \$150,000 in areawide funds were appropriated for Phase I of redesign for the Sutton Ambulance Building; and

WHEREAS, in the fiscal year 2016 Areawide Ambulance Operations Budget, \$30,000 was transferred to project no. 10179-1801 to continue with Phase I of the Sutton Ambulance Building Redesign project; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that there is still additional funds needed to continue with this project; and

WHEREAS, in the 2014 capital projects budget, \$180,000 in areawide funds were appropriated for Ambulance Replacement and Equipment purchase; and

WHEREAS, that project is now complete and there is a residual balance of \$13,968; and

WHEREAS, the Emergency Medical Services Deputy Director has requested that the balance of \$13,968 be reappropriated from project no. 45225-1817 to project no. 10179-1801 to complete the Phase I of the Sutton Ambulance Building Redesign project.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Acceptance and appropriation source. The Assembly does hereby reappropriate \$13,968 from the fiscal year 2014 areawide capital appropriation, fund 425, project no. 45225, to project no. 10179, fund 425 to complete the Phase I of the Sutton Ambulance Building Redesign project.

Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
