**MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 16-019**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING \$25,000 FROM THE MAT-SU SKI CLUB TO FUND 490, PROJECT N. 75005, FOR TRAIL LIGHTING FOR GOVERNMENT PEAK RECREATION AREA.

WHEREAS, the Borough was notified by the Mat-Su Ski Club that donated funds were available in the amount of \$25,000 to help pay for trail lighting on the Susitna Loop at the Government Peak Recreation Area; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly must approve an ordinance to accept and appropriate these funds; and

WHEREAS, no expenditures can be made until the scope of work and budget has been approved by the Assembly.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.


Section 2. Acceptance and appropriation source. There is hereby accepted and appropriated by the Assembly \$25,000 from the Mat-Su Ski Club to the following:

- 1) Trail Lighting on the Susitna Loop
at the Government Peak Recreation
Area.
Fund 490/Project No. 75005 \$25,000

Section 3. Authorization. The Manager is hereby authorized to negotiate, execute, and administer any and all documents, amendments, and agreements required for granting funds to the Borough.

Section 4. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.


