**MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 16-040**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROVING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION OF \$24,000 FROM THE CASWELL FIRE SERVICE AREA FUND BALANCE, FUND 248, TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2016 CASWELL FIRE SERVICE AREA OPERATING BUDGET TO COVER WAGES AND BENEFITS FOR THE REMAINDER OF FISCAL YEAR 2016.

WHEREAS, the Caswell Fire Service Area was fortunate to add seven new responders to their roster in fiscal year 2016; and

WHEREAS, the addition of the new responders was unanticipated and therefore adequate wages and benefits were not included during the budgeting process; and

WHEREAS, the Caswell Fire Service Area's fiscal year 2016 operating budget is currently in a deficit due to the unbudgeted expenses related to the addition of the new employees; and

WHEREAS, the Caswell Fire Service Area Board of Supervisors has approved a \$24,000 fund balance appropriation to supplement the fiscal year 2016 operating budget for payroll expenses.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Supplemental Appropriation source. The Assembly hereby approves a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$24,000 from the Caswell Fire Service Area fund

balance, fund 248, to the Caswell Fire Service Area Fiscal Year 2016 Operating Budget to cover wages and benefits for the remainder of fiscal year 2016.

Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
