**MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 16-043**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROVING AN APPROPRIATION OF \$220,000 FROM THE WILLOW FIRE SERVICE AREA FUND BALANCE, FUND 258, TO PROJECT NO. 45274, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A WILLOW FIRE SERVICE AREA WARM STORAGE BUILDING AT FOUR MILE ROAD.

WHEREAS, on August 26, 2014, with Ordinance Serial No. 14-103 the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly accepted and appropriated a grant in the amount of \$388,000 from the Alaska State Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development for the construction of a Willow warm storage building at Four Mile Road; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds remaining after the deduction of Borough administrative fees is \$368,600, and it has been determined that this amount of funding will be inadequate to complete the new warm storage building; and

WHEREAS, the Willow Fire Service Area Board of Supervisors has approved a \$220,000 fund balance appropriation to project no. 45274 to construct the warm storage building at Four Mile Road.


BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Appropriation source. The Assembly hereby approves an appropriation in the amount of \$220,000 from the Willow Fire Service Area Fund Balance, fund 258, to project no. 45274 for the construction of the Willow warm storage building at Four Mile Road.

Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.


