A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROVING THE AMENDED SCOPE OF WORK AND BUDGET FOR THE ALASKA STATE DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT GRANT, PROJECT NUMBER 45158-4415, FUND 425, FOR EMERGENCY OPERATION CENTER SOFTWARE, INCIDENT COMMAND SYSTEM TRAINING, AND EXERCISE SUPPLIES AND CONTRACT SUPPORT.

WHEREAS, on November 19, 2014, with Ordinance Serial No. 14-153, the Borough accepted and appropriated an Alaska State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management grant in the amount of \$68,420 for emergency operations center software (EOC) and incident command systems (ICS) training; and

WHEREAS, the Alaska State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management has awarded the Borough additional funding in the amount of \$4,290 under the 2014 Alaska State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management grant for exercise supplies and contract support; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly is required to approve and adopt a scope of work and budget for each capital project prior to the expenditure of said funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Assembly approves the amended scope of work and budget for the Alaska State

Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management Grant,  
project no. 45158-4415, fund 425.
