A RESOLUTION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY AMENDING THE SCOPE OF WORK FOR PROJECT NO. 45051, TO INCLUDE PAVING, LIGHTING, AND SAFETY BOLLARDS AT SUTTON FIRE STATION 1-1.

WHEREAS, on January 26, 2016, with Resolution No. 16-005, the Assembly approved an amended scope of work and budget for project 45051-6603; and

WHEREAS, since the adoption of Resolution Serial No. 16-005, the scope of work has expanded on this project to include safety related upgrades and access road paving; and

WHEREAS, it is considered prudent to install safety bollards to help prevent accidental damage to the structures while filling; and

WHEREAS, exterior lighting will provide the responders with a safer work area after dark and deter vandalism and theft from the station; and

WHEREAS, the access road paving will enable easier fill access and prevent road deterioration.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Assembly hereby approves the amended scope of work for project no. 45051.

SCOPE OF WORK

Water storage tank, pump, well, and paved access driveway; safety upgrades to include exterior lighting and bollards, for Station 1-1.
