**MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH  
ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 16-057**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROVING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION OF \$42,000 FROM THE TALKEETNA FIRE SERVICE AREA FUND BALANCE, FUND 254, TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2016 TALKEETNA FIRE SERVICE AREA OPERATING BUDGET TO COVER WAGES AND BENEFITS FOR THE REMAINDER OF FISCAL YEAR 2016.

WHEREAS, the Talkeetna Fire Service Area is currently over budget in personnel wages due to unforeseen expenses; and

WHEREAS, unexpected personnel costs were incurred from fighting the Sockeye Fire; and

WHEREAS, Emergency Management administrative staff have been being paid on a cost share basis between all fire service areas; and

WHEREAS, the fire service areas were not aware the personnel costs were being deducted from their budgets for Emergency Management employees, and therefore, they did not budget for the additional costs; and

WHEREAS, the Emergency Services Fire Deputy Director has approved a \$42,000 fund balance appropriation to supplement the fiscal year 2016 operating budget for payroll expenses.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Supplemental appropriation source. The Assembly hereby approves a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$42,000 from the Talkeetna Fire Service Area fund balance, fund 254, to the Talkeetna Fire Service Area fiscal year 2016 operating budget to cover wages and benefits for the remainder of fiscal year 2016.

Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
