**MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 16-097**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING A \$9,676 ALASKA STATE DIVISION OF FORESTRY VOLUNTEER FIRE ASSISTANCE GRANT AND REQUESTING A REAPPROPRIATION OF \$1,075 FROM THE TALKEETNA FIRE SERVICE AREA FISCAL YEAR 2017 OPERATING BUDGET, FUND 254, TO PROJECT NO. 20145, FUND 405, FOR WILDLAND/FIRE EQUIPMENT AND CLOTHING.

WHEREAS, the Borough has been notified that the Talkeetna Fire Service Area has been awarded a grant in the amount of \$9,676 from the Alaska State Division of Forestry, under the Volunteer Fire Assistance Program; and

WHEREAS, the fire service area is required to provide matching funds in the amount of \$1,075 in order to comply with the conditions of the grant and to receive the grant; and

WHEREAS, the scope of work and budget are contained in Resolution Serial No. 16-064; and

WHEREAS, the acceptance and appropriation of the grant funds serves a public interest.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Grant acceptance. The Assembly does hereby authorize the acceptance of a grant from the Alaska State Division of Forestry and agrees to comply with the applicable provisions.

Section 3. Appropriation and Reappropriation source. The Assembly hereby appropriates the amount of \$9,676 from the Alaska State Division of Forestry Volunteer Fire Assistance Grant Program and reappropriates the amount of \$1,075 from the Talkeetna Fire Service Area Fiscal Year 2017 Operating Budget fund 254, to project no. 20145, fund 405, for wildland/fire equipment and clothing.


Section 4. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
