**MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH  
ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 16-101**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING 2015 SOCKEYE FIRE DISASTER RELIEF MONIES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$43,583.61 FROM THE ALASKA STATE DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT TO FUND 445, PROJECT NO. 55018.

WHEREAS, on June 14, 2015, a large wildland urban interface Alaska wildfire exacerbated by record high temperatures caused widespread damage to the community of Willow and the surrounding area in the Matanuska-Susitna Borough; and

WHEREAS, the fire resulted in the evacuation of both residential and commercial properties; and

WHEREAS, a disaster declaration was issued by the Manager and the Governor; and

WHEREAS, approximately 290 tons of charred wood, metal, mixed vegetative debris, and other detritus had been deposited throughout areas of the Borough, posing access issues for emergency vehicles, as well as health and safety hazards for residents within the communities; and

WHEREAS, \$43,583.61 of expenditures from the disaster for debris removal have been determined eligible for State assistance.

BE IT ENACTED:


Section 1. Classification. This Ordinance is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Acceptance source. The Assembly does hereby authorize the acceptance of the 2015 Sockeye Fire relief monies in the amount of \$43,583.61 from the Alaska State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management.

Section 3. Appropriation source. The Assembly hereby appropriates the 2015 Sockeye Fire relief monies in the amount of \$43,583.61 from the Alaska State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management, to fund 445, Emergency/Disaster Capital Project, project no. 55018.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
