ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 16-121**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING \$14,960 FROM THE ALASKA STATE DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT GRANT PROGRAM, TO FUND 425, PROJECT NO. 45158, FOR HAZARDOUS MATERIALS DETECTION EQUIPMENT.

WHEREAS, the Borough has been awarded an Alaska State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management grant in the amount of \$14,960; and

WHEREAS, the funds will be used for hazardous materials detection equipment; and

WHEREAS, the scope of work and budget are contained in Resolution Serial No. 16-082; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Assembly must accept and appropriate the \$14,960 from the Alaska State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management prior to the expenditure of said funds; and

WHEREAS, no expenditures can be made until the scope of work and budget have been approved by the Assembly.

BE IT ENACTED:

Section 1. Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.


Section 2. Acceptance and appropriation source. The

amount of \$14,960 from the Alaska State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management grant program, and approves an appropriation in the amount of \$14,960 from the Alaska State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management grant program, to fund 425, project no. 45158, for hazardous materials detection equipment.

Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
