**MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 16-122**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING \$96,492 FROM THE ALASKA STATE DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AND VETERAN'S AFFAIRS, EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PERFORMANCE GRANT PROGRAM (EMPG), AND REQUESTING A REAPPROPRIATION OF \$96,492 FROM THE EMERGENCY SERVICES ADMINISTRATION FISCAL YEAR 2017 OPERATING BUDGET TO FUND 425, PROJECT NO. 45285.

WHEREAS, the Borough has received a grant from the Alaska State Department of Military and Veteran's Affairs; and

WHEREAS, the funds will be used for Emergency Management wages and benefits; and

WHEREAS, the Borough is required to provide matching funds in the amount of \$96,492 in order to comply with the conditions of the grant and to receive the grant; and

WHEREAS, the scope of work and budget are contained in Resolution Serial No. 16-083; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly must accept and appropriate the \$96,492 from the Alaska State Department of Military and Veteran's affairs prior to the expenditure of said funds; and

WHEREAS, no expenditures can be made until the scope of work and budget have been approved by the Assembly.

BE IT ENACTED:


Section 1. Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Grant acceptance. The Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly does hereby authorize the acceptance of a grant in the amount of \$96,492 from the Alaska State Department of Military and Veteran's Affairs and agrees to comply with the applicable provisions.

Section 3. Appropriation and reappropriation source. The Matanuska-Susitna Borough Assembly hereby appropriates the amount of \$96,492 from the Alaska State Department of Military and Veteran's Affairs, Emergency Management Performance Grant Program and reappropriates the amount of \$96,492 from the Emergency Services Administration fiscal year 2017 operating budget, fund 100, to project no. 45285, fund 425, for Emergency Management wages and benefits.

Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
