This addendum is being issued to clarify certain aspects of the Scope of Services contained in the original Bid Documents.

Question #1: Who currently provides MSB's Microsoft Enterprise Agreement?

Answer #1: PCM-G

Question #2: In the MSB IT Budget presentation from 2017 to 2018 there was a decrease of \$150,000 directly noted to the Microsoft Enterprise Agreement. Would MSB consider transitioning to Office 365 in the cloud as an option?

Answer #2: Unsure what MSB IT Budget presentation that is being referred to. The previous Enterprise Agreement lasted 6 years. The first three year period (FY15-FY17) was mostly licensing costs for new software and the second three year period (FY18-FY20) was mostly software assurance costs on existing licensed software. MSB is currently licensed for on-prem and O365 options. Some functionality used by MSB is currently hosted on Office 365 such as Microsoft Teams but this does not include the Office applications which are currently loaded on local devices. MSB will transition more services to O365 over time but does not plan to move everything to O365 at the beginning of this new enterprise agreement.

Question #3: Would the Matanuska-Susitna Borough consider a Microsoft CSP agreement in lieu of a Microsoft EA (Enterprise Agreement)?

Answer #3: No. At this time we have on-prem licensing in place that limits our ability to utilize a Microsoft CSP. We may change our on-prem licensing mix over the next three years but will be locked into the Microsoft Enterprise Agreement (EA) for the next three years starting July 1, 2020.
