

<p><b>The following corrections, changes, additions, deletions, revisions, and/or clarifications are hereby made a part of the Contract Documents. In case of conflicts between this Addendum and previously issued Documents, this Addendum shall take precedence. The Bidder must acknowledge receipt of this Addendum in the space provided on the Submittal Page. Failure to do so may subject the Bidder to disqualification.</b></p>										
<p>This addendum is being issued to clarify certain aspects of the original Bid Documents and Scope of Work.</p>										
<p><b>Question #1:</b> Considering an extension of the contract and material vendors not guaranteeing pricing for more than 90 days, the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> year material pricing is expected to increase. There is no provision for an increase per pound in the second and third contract year except through "...mutual agreement....." in the extension provision. Can a reasonable price increase be added into the second- and third-year contract years?</p>										
<p><b>Answer #1:</b> Contract extensions for years 2 and 3 will be executed through mutual agreement between the Borough and the Contractor. Mutual agreement in part, will be pricing for the upcoming season. With the contract expiring on September 30, 2019, the contractor will have ample time to obtain material pricing for the upcoming season prior to the actual contract renewal. The Contractor may request a contract price per pound increase after:</p>										
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>&gt; proving due diligence by providing a minimum of 3 material price quotes showing the price increase</li> <li>&gt; provide crack sealing material invoice(s) from previous year(s) material purchase</li> </ul>										
<p>The Borough will review the request and determine whether to allow the contract increase or to re-bid the Crack Sealing project. The Borough also reserves the right to obtain material price quotes for comparison and to reduce the renewal contract price per pound for each contract extension option.</p>
