PROJECT FACTS

General Project Scope

Design and construct upgrades to the athletic fields at school facilities district-wide.

Benefits & Scope Details

Design and construct a new competition-style track and field facility with jumping pits and an artificial track surface at Su Valley High School and Palmer Junior Middle School.

Design and construct ball field upgrades at Wasilla & Houston High School.

Design and construct improvements to multi-use play courts and fields at Glacier View, Finger Lake, Iditarod, Larson, and Snowshoe Elementary Schools.

Status

October 4th, 2011 – Borough voters approved funding of this \$6.46M School Bond project, as part of the \$214M School Bond package.

March 2014 – Borough sold bonds to allow award of the design contract.

April 2014 – Borough awarded the design contract to STANTEC.

August 2014 – Borough awarded the 2014 upgrades to Tutka Construction.

May 2015 – Tutka completed the 2014 court and field upgrades at three elementary schools, Houston High ball fields and GVS south side.

May 2015 – Borough awarded the 2015 upgrades to Prosser-Dagg Construction to upgrade track surfaces at PJMS and SVHS, ball fields at WHS and hockey rink at GVS.

August 2016 – WHS fields ready for 2017.
