## PROJECT FACTS

### Project Scope

This project is scoped to replace existing generator sets and switch gear with backup generators and new switching gear.

### Benefits

Generators will facilitate normal operations during outages during the school day and will support the entire building during emergencies allowing school to continue without interruption.

In January 2016, the project was competitively bid. An award was made to Wolverine Supply, Inc. as the general contractor. Construction is underway and the project is scheduled to be complete by summer 2017.

- Big Lake Elementary School
- Butte Elementary School
- Snowshoe Elementary School
- Willow Elementary School
- Operations & Maintenance building

### Project Budget

The total project budget is \$2,600,000, with 70% reimbursement from the State of Alaska.
