

# Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Will any boundary changes affect my taxes?

A: No. Property taxes are not affected by community council boundaries.

Q: Will any boundary changes affect the regulations on my property?

A: No. No additional regulations will apply to your parcel. These properties are all currently within the Core Area, and are not proposed to be removed or added to the Core Area.

Q: Do the residents or property owners get to vote on any boundary changes?

A: No. Any amendments to community council boundaries are subject to final approval by the assembly.

Q: What section of borough code covers community councils?

A: Community Councils are subject to MSB 2.76 *Community Councils*. [MSB 2.76](#)

Q: Will any boundary changes affect the Road Service or Fire Service Area boundaries, or Assembly Districts?

A: No. Those will all remain unchanged.

Q: Will these boundary changes affect whether or not a community council is active or “inactive” (See MSB 2.76.030(C) *Inactive Status of Community Councils*)

A: No.

Q: Will these boundary changes affect any other section of MSB 2.76?

A: No.
